The children have been learning about rhyming words ready to write a poem.


This week in literacy we have written poems about Diplodocus Dan. Some children were given two verses where they had to put in the rhyming words while others had to write their own second verse.

Diplodocus Dan

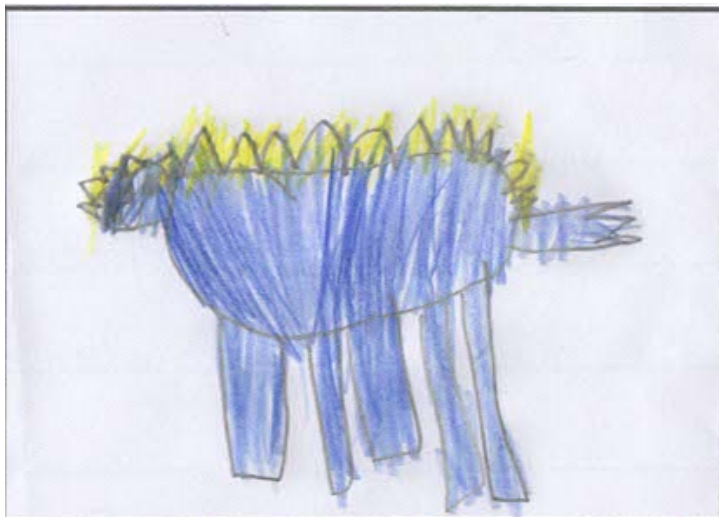
Word bank: tall tan
