We will be starting a learning log support session for parent/carers of Year R. The purpose of this session is to provide parents with a place where they can find out how to help their child complete their learning log for that week. Each week the children are given different learning objectives. If you find that one week you do not understand the objective come and see us and we will help you so you can support your child at home. The drop-in sessions will run weekly and if you find that you understand the homework for that week you don't need to attend.

You will not be required to stay for the whole session. Once you feel you have understood the homework objectives for that week you can leave.

Parental involvement has been shown to be a key determinant of educational achievement. Helping your child with homework is a key way of building children's confidence, abilities and respect for school and education.

Why is homework important?

- Review and practice what they have covered in class;
- Learn to use resources, such as libraries, reference materials, and Web sites;
- Explore subjects more fully than classroom time allows;
- Extend learning by applying skills they already have to new situations;
- Learn to manage time and meet deadlines.
