In Literacy, children have written some amazing Newspaper reports based on the Battle of Bosworth. Here is a list of some of the language children have used this week: enemies, nemesis, rival, cruelty, charged, disarmed, assembled.

In Numeracy, we continue our three week unit on Place Value. In this topic, children will learn the following:

- recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number (100s, 10s, 1s)
- compare and order numbers up to 1,000
- read and write numbers up to 1,000 in numerals and in words

Over the last couple of weeks, we have started reading Charlotte's Web. We continue to meet some very unusual characters. The main character, Wilbur, has finally made a friend! But she is not anything like him. Will they stay friends?



All classes have now started Spanish lessons. Children have been introduced to the numbers 1 - 10 in Spanish. We hope to work on this knowledge over the next few weeks to develop fluency.
