A warm welcome back to a fresh school year. We hope you all had amazing summer breaks.

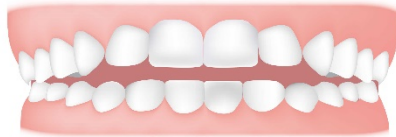
We have had a super first week in Year 3! The children have settled well into routines and have made lots of new friends in their new classes. We have an exciting term ahead.

This week we have introduced the children to our first topic: The Tudors. Literacy and Topic lessons over the next few weeks will focus on this topic. Children have already learnt about some of the kings and queens of the Tudor period. They have also had great fun learning about the battle of Bosworth! We used role play and drama as a means to understand the events of the battle.

In Numeracy, we have started a three week unit on Place Value. In this topic, children will learn the following:

- recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number (100s, 10s, 1s)
- compare and order numbers up to 1,000
- read and write numbers up to 1,000 in numerals and in words

In Science, children have started learning about the different types of teeth and their functions.
