This week in topic, the children have been making landmarks out of different materials whilst discussing the properties of these materials and their effectiveness. They discussed why their materials were good or bad for their landmarks and why. In addition, after making their landmark out of their chosen material, the children evaluated their design and discussed how to improve them next time.

In numeracy we have been learning about the properties of 2D shapes. We compared squares and triangles and found out that a shape with four straight sides is not always a square, it could also be a rectangle. We also learnt to identify triangles and circles

In phonics, Set 3 sounds are a little trickier as there are different spelling patterns that make the same sound. An example is oi and oy. Here they have to learn the spelling patterns as well for example oy is often at the end of a word and oi in the middle. Here are the set 3 sounds.

ow ew ire ear ure
