Last Thursday morning, the children went on a walk around the local area. They had a lot of fun trying to spot buildings, places and shops in our local area. From this, the children will be sequencing the events of their walk to write a recount. In order to do this, the children have looked at verbs (action words) and using them in the past tense. We also emphasise the importance of thinking of a sentence, saying, writing and checking it so that their work make sense. The children have also started to edit their work, meaning they improve a given sentence using the features we have learnt.

In science, the children were introduced to the difference between summer and winter. They looked at the weather and all the different clothes we wear according to the weather.

In numeracy we have been learning about subtraction. The children have been using cubes and drawings to represent what the number sentences mean in order to work out the answers.

Next week, we will be having our class assemblies so we hope to see as many parents and carers as we can.
