We have been working very hard in Year 3 over the last few weeks.

This half term's topic has been amazing! The children have learnt so much about the Polar Regions. They also know how global warming is having a negative impact on these regions of the world.

In Literacy this week, children have started a two week narrative unit. We read a short version of the Snow Queen. This story introduces children to the concept of adventure. We hope at the end of this unit, children will write their own well thought through adventure stories.

In Numeracy, children have finished a two week unit on Multiplication and Division. This week we have started looking at: Time. We have already learnt:

- Some months have 31 days and that some months do not.
- Time vocabulary such as noon, midday and midnight
- Number of hours in a day
- How to tell the time to the nearest quarter of an hour.

We will continue our work on time next week.
