

## Year 1 spellings

### Spring 1

This year, in Year One, the children will be taught spelling rules and patterns from Monday until Thursday. These sessions will focus on preparing the children with the phonic skills the government requires and also to give them the tools needed to do well in the phonics screening test in the Summer term.

On Fridays, the children will be taught the spellings of common exception words and grammar rules.

Children will be having one spelling test on the last Friday of each term on the 'common exception words' taught that term or on spelling rules.

Children will not only need to spell the word correctly, but will need to be able to use these words in sentences as the spelling test will be in this format.

Below, you will find examples of spellings and rules to practise to support your child with their learning this half term.

We will be re-teaching some common exception words taught in the autumn term.
