This week in Literacy the children have started continued with their information report on Queen Elizabeth II. The information report corresponds with our topic for the term 'Kings and Queens', for which the children have learnt about the Royal Family, their heritage and traditions along with new vocabulary which they can use when working in Literacy.

In Numeracy last week, children have been exploring and drawing their own number lines to count on from the biggest number to show addition. Count back from the biggest number to show subtraction.

Last week in Computing the children looked at Fairy tales to gather some ideas about the illustrations. We talked about how the illustrations are made. The children then created their own illustrations of a familiar story.
