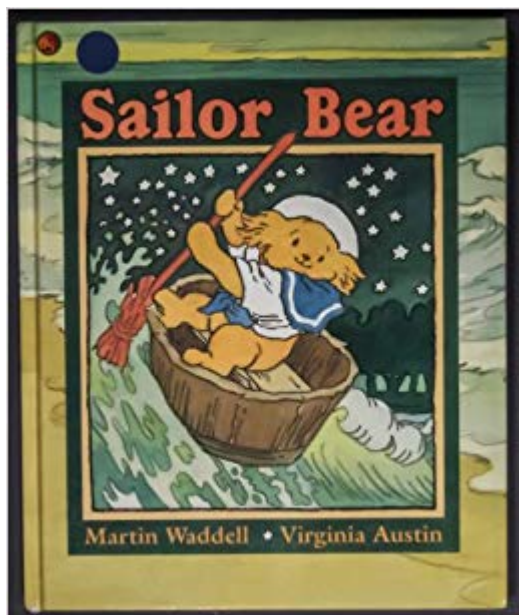


Week ending 25.09.20

We have encouraged the children to think aloud as a writer and to think, say, repeat, count words, write and check their work.
