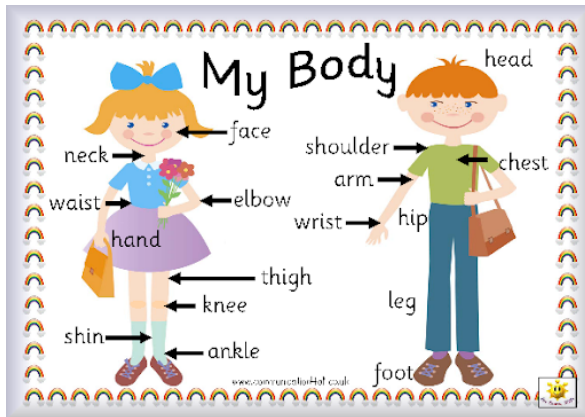


Week ending 02.10.20
