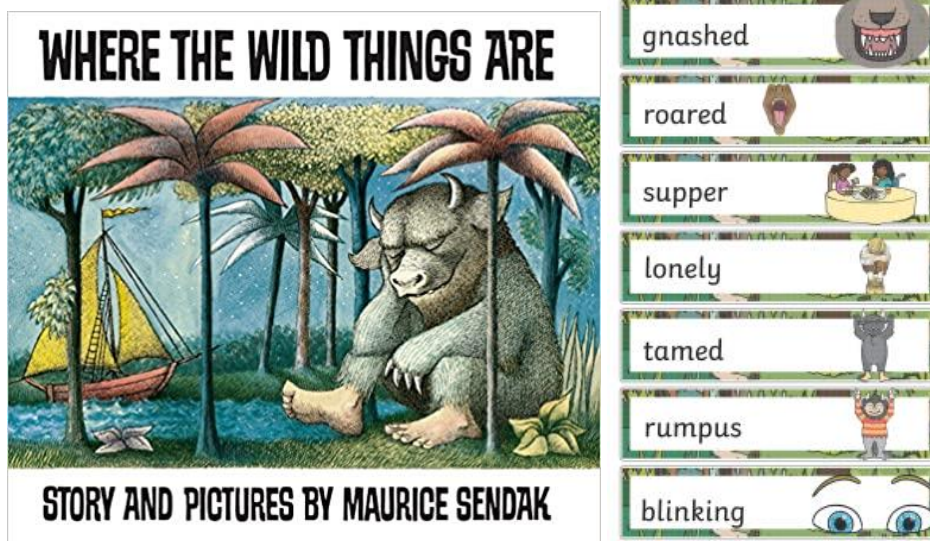


Week ending 13.11.20

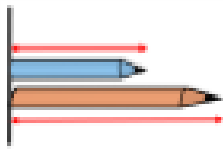


Ask your child to say a sentence using the new words!
