

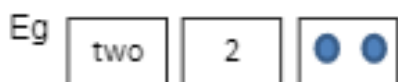
Year 1

This week in Numeracy, we have been looking at numbers from 1-10. We read and wrote numbers in words and numerals. Children were matching numerals with words, joining numbers with dot to dot games and word searches.

Year 1 has also been looking at how to represent numbers using a range of objects/resources e.g. counters, cubes, teddies, pencils etc. Children need to understand how a number means the same amount regardless of the objects used.



In Literacy this week the children have been reading 'Sailor Bear'. We began by practising using 'because' and 'and' in our sentences to explain how we know something is true.

They have also been using story strips and actions to understand the sequence of the story while trying to describe and explain how the character is feeling. The children have been working hard in improving their letter formations.
