


Week ending: 12.11.21

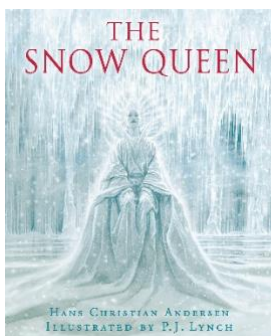
$$\begin{array}{r} 38 \\ + 93 \\ \hline 131 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
