What an action-packed week we've had!

The children have spent this week writing an excellent adventure story! They based their story sequence in line with the story of the Snow Queen and innovated new exciting characters and events. All the teachers are very pleased with how well the children used subordinating conjunctions, exciting verbs, speech and adverbs in their writing. Well done Superstars!

In maths we have started learning the 3s, 4s and 8 times tables. We've developed our understanding of these times tables and can now write the commutative calculations eg. $4 \times 3 = 12$ so $3 \times 4 = 12$ so $12 \div 4 = 3$ so $12 \div 3 = 4$ we also have practised how to show this information using circles, bar models and as repeated addition. If your child is still unsure of these times tables please help them by practising them at home.

In geography we have researched what global warming is, what is causing it, what effect global warming is having on the planet and what we can do to slow it down. The children were so interested in this subject as it is something that will personally affect them as they grow older.

In science we have continued to look at the endoskeletons of arctic animals. The children successfully identified and named the bones and discovered why certain animal's skeletons have been adapted to suit the environment in which they live.

On Friday we had house meetings and the wonderful house captains delivered a special assembly on anti-bullying and kindness.
