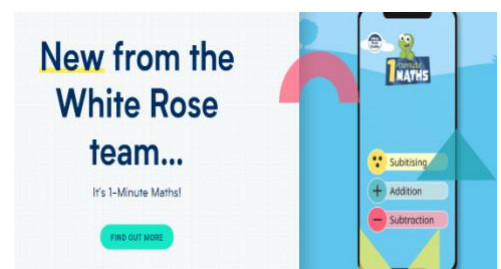
Here are a few photos from Humboldt class visit to: The Wardown Park Museum trip
