

Week ending: 7th January

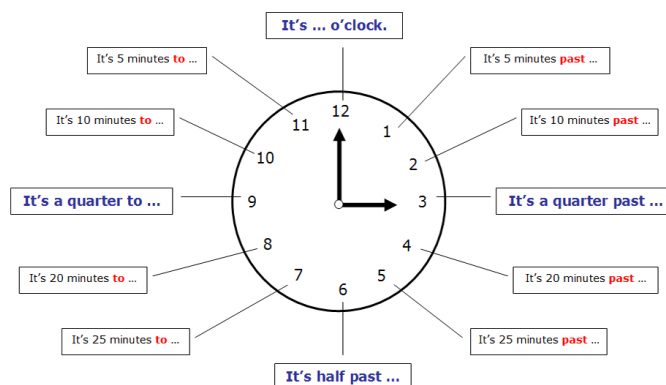
