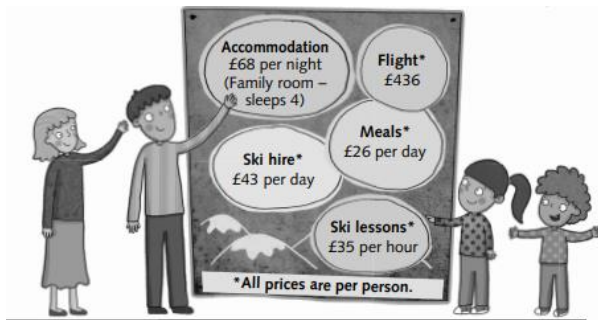


Week beginning 24/01/22

In Numeracy this week we continued our learning to apply all the four operations to solve multi-step word problems.



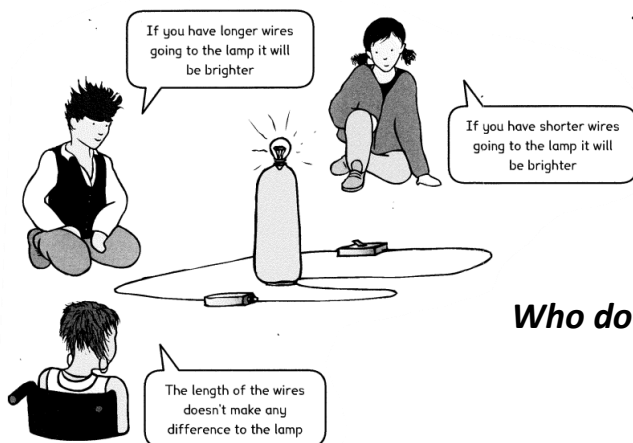
The family hire skis and are offered a discount: book for 2 weeks and receive 4 of the days free. What is the total cost of ski hire for the family?
